## The Power of Words in Song

**Matthew 26:1–27:31, Mark 14:1-15:20, Luke 22:1 -23:25**

**Readings from the Hymnal:** Reading: # 219 "Gethsamane",

#210 "Christ's Passion"

#### **Hymn Studies:**

Pick one of the following hymns, then read the scripture listed under the title. Read the lyrics and reflect on their meanings. Write down ideas that come to you or questions you may have. Also write down thoughts you have that God is putting on your heart. Pick another and do the same – you may not want to do all of them. Enjoy your readings and reflections.
